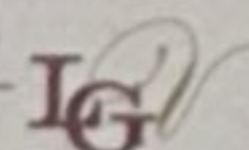


SONOMA MOUNTAIN VINEYARD

Laurel Glen Vineyard, located a thousand feet up the east-facing slope of Sonoma Mountain, was first planted to Cabernet Sauvignon in 1968. The site has consistently proven to be exceptionally well suited to Cabernet Sauvignon. The elevated location ensures generous sun in the morning and the eastern exposure spares the vines from the oppressive afternoon heat, enabling a longer ripening period. The rocky, mountain soils place stress on the vines, constraining the size of the fruit and concentrating the flavors. The result is a Cabernet Sauvignon with an intensity, complexity, and a balanced acidity that is very unusual for California.

Laurel Glen Vineyard founder Patrick Campbell discovered he had inherited a unique clone of Cabernet Sauvignon when he bought the property in 1977, today recognized as the Laurel Glen clone by U.C. Davis. In 2011, after 30 vintages, Patrick Campbell sold the vineyard and winery to a small group of wine lovers led by Bettina Sichel, whose family has been in the wine business in Europe for five generations.

Today, organic viticulture guru Phil Coturri manages the vineyard and talented winemaker Randall Watkins manages the cellar. They have implemented many quality-oriented improvements including certified organic farming, updated pruning and trellising methods and triple-sorting of the grapes at harvest. The result is evident in the current releases: structured mountain wines that are also supple, intense, fragrant, and balanced.

Laurel Glen Vineyard Lot Series Cabernet Sauvignon

Our smallest production Cabernet and the wine with the biggest, most exuberant personality. Each year we look for the barrels from our Estate vineyard with the most power and biggest flavors and then we wait five years to release the wine - just when it is starting to integrate its many elements. *Typical production: 200 cases*

Library Re-Release

Because our vineyard produces Cabernet Sauvignon that ages slowly and gracefully, we cellar a significant amount for later release. Each year, we re-release one or two vintages of our flagship Estate Cabernet Sauvignon with enough bottle age to beautifully illustrate how much better Cabernet gets with time.
