## **CREATIVE TEAM**

MARK SFORZINI (General Director/Conductor) is not merely a visionary leader who established an innovative and successful nonprofit business (although he is, and he did). He is a composer whose orchestral and chamber works have been commissioned and performed by the Florida Orchestra, Tampa Bay Symphony, Alabama Symphony, Omaha Symphony, Eastern Music Festival, Toledo Symphony Orchestra and numerous others. He has written and produced several one-act opera and music programs based on operatic repertoire. Sforzini's acclaimed Concerto for Clarinet and Bassoon debuted in 2018.

The Alabama native served as principal bassoon of the Florida Orchestra from 1992 to 2007. He was the artistic director of the prestigious Encore Series of chamber music at the Palladium Theater for several years. He co-founded FloriMezzo in 2003, serving as its artistic director for five years. In addition, he was Music Director of the Pinellas Youth Symphony and a composer-mentor for Hillsborough County Schools.

In 2005, he was invited to guest-conduct a one-time production of Madama Butterfly at the Palladium Theater. And so, St. Petersburg Opera Company was born.

Far from resting on his considerable laurels, Sforzini continues to stretch, to test the boundaries of what an opera company can and should be. Each season brings several lavishly-staged and fully-orchestrated productions of classic operas, pops and cabaret shows, a children's introduction to opera, seasonal showcases, and other vastly entertaining offerings.

In addition to his duties as St. Pete Opera's general director, chief visionary, arranger, and conductor, Maestro Sforzini is in demand as an adjudicator, clinician, and chamber music coach. Since 2012, he has been music director and conductor of the Tampa Bay Symphony and established a Call for Scores Competition to promote 21st-century works by composers worldwide. Mark Sforzini was chosen by Musical America as one of 30 international industry professionals as a "Profile in Courage." These top industry leaders have "taken a risk, spoken out where others were silent - all to the measurable benefits of their arts organizations and the field." www.marksforzini.com

> FELIX JARRAR (Assistant Conductor) is a multidisciplinary artist, distinguished as a composer, coach and conductor. Jarrar has had the privilege of collaborating with numerous esteemed organizations, including Santa Fe Opera, OPERA San Antonio, The New School, Opera Naples, Opera North, Opera Ithaca, Penn Square Opera, Hogfish, University of Memphis and the iconic Apollo Theater.

For the 2025/2026 season, he returns for a second season as Assistant Conductor with Florida Grand Opera, working on productions of Silent Night, Die Fledermaus, and Turandot. Jarrar's impressive compositional catalog comprises 275 works, including 235 art songs, 14 operas, two string quartets, and a symphony.

HELENA BINDER (Stage Director & Choreographer) has been a theater professional for more than 40 years and has brought her wit and warmth to many of the finest companies in the United States. Known for her masterful sense of timing and for fostering natural, genuine and moving performances, her innovative and imaginative productions have been seen at New York City Opera, Dallas, Minnesota, Atlanta, Pittsburgh, Palm Beach, Portland, Anchorage and Shreveport Opera, Wolf Trap, Opera Saratoga, Opera Omaha, Opera

Idaho, Opera North, Chattanooga Symphony and Opera, Syracuse, Roanoke and Toledo Opera, among many others.

A choreographer as well, Ms. Binder has collaborated with such notable directors as Frank Corsaro, Simon Callow and Christopher Alden and has created dances for New York City Opera, Dallas, Pittsburgh and the Glimmerglass Festival, where she also went on for an ailing countertenor.

An accomplished actor, Helena has performed roles ranging from Peter Pan to Shakespeare's Juliet. She was a member of the band Blotto, that recorded the hit "I Wanna Be A Lifeguard," and about which a documentary has recently been released. Named a Union Notable by her alma mater, Union College, she holds an M.A. from New York University and studied acting at Circle in the Square. Ms. Binder has been on the faculty of Union College, Boston University and the New England Conservatory, as well as a guest teacher at Dartmouth College. www.helenabinder.com.
